In February 2024, we donated \$21,000

We donated **\$5,000 to Story Dogs**, an amazing group that helps kids enjoy reading and become confident readers. They don't get government funds or payments from schools.

We're thrilled to join forces with **Read the Play** with a donation of **\$10,000** to broaden support to parents and club player wellbeing officers/club committees/coaches around mental health issues.

A **\$6,000** donation was made to support a young woman dealing with a serious health diagnosis.

During the Christmas period, we managed to fulfill emergency requests amounting to \$28,000, including \$10,000 each to a young woman in a severe accident and Northern Futures, an organization aiding disadvantaged people in Geelong. We gave \$2,000 to a mother for her son's funeral costs and \$3,000 to a family who lost their son and daughter in law in an accident, leaving behind an 8 year old. We also helped a single mother with \$1,000 to ensure her child had school necessities.

In March 2024, we donated \$15,400

We donated **\$10,000 to Hope Bereavement Care**, a compassionate organisation in Geelong that offers crucial support and counseling to individuals mourning the loss of a loved one, whether it's a child, an adult, or due to suicide. Their remarkable efforts bring hope to our community during the darkest times.

We also contributed **\$2,400 to the Ballarat Police and Citizens Youth Club**, providing a range of beneficial programs for young people who are socially disadvantaged or disengaged in the Ballarat area, nurturing their well being and growth.

Our hearts ached for a family grappling with their little girl's cancer diagnosis, a reality too painful for any parent to envisage. We supported this family with a \$3,000 donation to support them through this incredibly challenging period.

Additionally, we continued our commitment to ongoing support through our monthly donations:

- \$2,000 monthly to Cottage by the Sea
- \$2,000 monthly to Feed Me Bellarine
- \$3,000 monthly to the Meli Emergency Relief
- \$1,700 monthly to Geelong Food Relief.
